

E-Bike Raffle Rules

ELIGIBILITY

The Canadian Liver Foundation's E-Bike Raffle is conducted by the Canadian Liver Foundation (the "Sponsor") and is open to all legal residents of Alberta. Entrants must be 18 years of age at the time of entry. This raffle is open to the public.

Entrants are not eligible to participate in the Contest if they are:

1. employees, agents or representatives of the Sponsor or its affiliates; or
2. The Sponsor shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof within a reasonable period of time may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to the Sponsor for the purpose of this Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate, and in no way misleading.

HOW TO ENTER

Raffle Tickets can be purchased online for 1/\$25 or 5/\$100. The Contest ends on Sunday, September 12 at 11:59:59 PM. All times listed in these Contest Rules refer to Mountain Standard Time.

PRIZE

The prize to be awarded to the winner by random draw is a NEW Elby E-Bike. Approximate retail value of the Prize is \$3600 CDN.

The Prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned, sold, substituted, or redeemed for cash, except that the Sponsor in its sole discretion, reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the Prize cannot be awarded as described due to unavailability for any reason.

RANDOM DRAW

On Tuesday September 14, 2021 at 11:00 AM at the Canadian Liver Foundation Alberta Regional Office in Calgary, Alberta, one eligible entry

will be selected by random draw from all eligible entries received. The winner of the raffle draw will be contacted on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 after the completion of the draw. Odds of winning are dependent on the number of eligible entries received.

If more than one name is written on the winning ticket, the prize will be awarded to only one individual named on the ticket. Neither the licensed charitable organization nor the AGLC is responsible for any disputes among the individuals whose names are written on the ticket stub.

By participating in this Contest, entrant agrees to be bound by the contest rules.

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

By participating in the Contest, the entrant consents to the collection, use and disclosure of his/her personal information by the Sponsor for the purpose of administering the Contest, awarding the Prize and announcing the Winner and any subsequent advertising or promotion related thereto. Personal information collected in connection with the Contest will be used by the Sponsor for future communications which the entrant may discontinue at any time.
